Dear Assemblyman ~~Solorio~~:

The Garden Grove City Council has a policy of permitting meetings "pertaining to a world class destination resort and gaming complex in Garden Grove". Within the last three months, the City has been approached by representatives of the Gabrieleno tribe of Mission Indians, for the purpose of considering the feasibility and advisability of such a complex. I have met with these representatives and in my view the overtures deserve further consideration. As an entertainment venture, any possible location for the entertainment complex would be in all likelihood located on Harbor Boulevard, in your district.

I am requesting that you extend all courtesies to these representatives as they explore the possibility of a resort casino and entertainment complex in Garden Grove. It is worthwhile to study their concept at both the local and state level. I stress that no decision has been made at the local level. There are no drawings, proposals, or submittals. However, this project has to get off the ground somewhere and initial exploration by local and state elected officials will inevitably be the starting point.
