Re: Vincent Holguin Awarded Gabrielino 4-Year College Scholarship To CSULB

Dear Tribal Member,

We have two very happy announcements.

First, we are extremely pleased to announce that Tribal Member Vincent Holguin, age 19, was awarded a Presidential Scholarship by Cal State Long Beach. Vincent was recommended by the Tribal Council after a formal application process with the Tribe. He will attend CSULB in the fall.

CSULB is the 9th largest educational institution in the country. President F. King Alexander awards 50 Presidential Scholarships each year, almost all of which go to valedictorians from California's high schools. For the 50 spots, over 700 valedictorians apply.

Vincent is a smart kid and a great guy, but not a valedictorian. He is a Gabrielino and a great representative of our Tribe. President Alexander wanted to recognize the long history that CSULB shares with the Tribe, and increase his outreach to the Native American community in Los Angeles County.

We in the Tribal Council, with Jonathan Stein and Bernie Acuna heading negotiations, procured one spot from President Alexander. It is a **full, 4-year scholarship** for tuition, room and board, books and incidentals (see letter and picture enclosed). The 4-year scholarship is valued at over \$220,000.

We will next attempt to procure at least one spot for each academic year in the future. And so we all look to Vincent to demonstrate that Gabrielino Tribal Members are an excellent addition to the CSULB community.

Please join us in congratulating Vincent Holguin for his achievement. We hope you will all share in the sense of pride we feel as Gabrielinos, to see this milestone achieved for the Tribe.

And second, we are pleased to announce that Tribal Member Vanessa Dominguez, age 17, was selected as *Miss Beaumont 2009*. The prestigious post is a long tradition at the City of Beaumont and has many important PR functions attached to it (see picture enclosed). Vanessa was an applicant for the Presidential Scholarship. **Please join us in congratulating Vanessa Dominguez for her achievement.**

- ◆ E-mail and Internet access

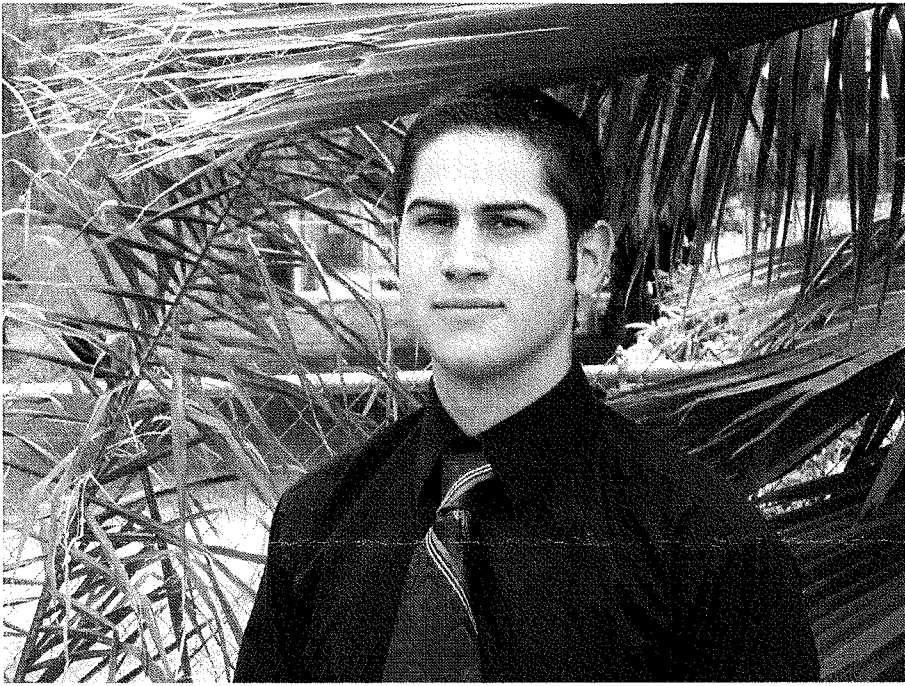
